**7<sup>th</sup> August 2013, 1.30 – 3.30pm – FELTING –** Learn how to felt and take home your own felting project

**21<sup>st</sup> August 2013 1.30 – 3.30pm - MOSAICS -** Make a 6" mosaic tile to use at home

**28<sup>th</sup> August 2013 1.3- 3.30pm - CLAY –** Make a clay rocket, planet or alien
